

# 2020 Summer Course for Juniors / Teenagers Ages 11-17\*

June 14th 2020 - Aug 23rd 2020



- Students arrive on a Sunday, and begin lessons on Monday. Departure day is normally a Sunday
- Lessons are Monday – Friday, 20 X 45 minute lessons per week (15 hours) in multinational classes
- 16 students per class maximum (Average class size for last summer was 12)
- Homestay accommodation, shared room, all meals (includes packed lunches)
- Homestay is usually 2 sharing a room, with 4 students maximum per host. Homestays are within 30 minutes' travel time of the school
- Homestay Hosts meet the students on arrival at the coach station in Torquay and take them to the coach station on the departure day
- \*11 and 12 year olds must be accompanied by an adult in Torquay
- Full Social Activity program with 4 afternoon activities/trips, 1 half-day excursion, 2 evening activities + 1 full-day excursion per week
- Course materials, end of course certificate and teacher's report included
- Welcome pack with local information
- 24 hour emergency support included
- School I.D card and map included
- BUS PASS for unlimited local travel included. Prices also include the registration fee.
- A non-refundable deposit of £200 is required to reserve a space on this course (this is taken off the balance owed).



